## NARRATIVE

On 08/31/08 at 2232 hours, I responded to [REDACTED], Fort Lauderdale in reference to a Domestic Disturbance. Prior to arrival, I made contact with victim [REDACTED] (B/P) at the 400 Block of NW 27th Ave Fort Lauderdale. [REDACTED] was noted to be crying and to have a small laceration to the top of her right eye which was bleeding. [REDACTED] was in the company of her father [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that her boyfriend Bell, Tharod [08/27/87] whom she has been dating for four months attacked her in their home which is located at the above listed address.

[REDACTED] stated that she was standing in her living room and was suddenly attacked without provocation by Bell. As the physical altercation moved from the living room to the bathroom, [REDACTED] stated that Bell stuck her on the right eye with a closed fist and caused the listed injury. [REDACTED] stated that her blood could now be found in the bath tub and on the floor of the bathroom. Following the attack [REDACTED] left the residence and proceeded on foot to her father's residence which is located at [REDACTED], Fort Lauderdale. [REDACTED] stated that she told her father she no longer wished to live with Bell. At that time [REDACTED] and her father returned on foot to the [REDACTED] residence in order to gather clothing. While attempting to walk towards the residence an argument ensued on the street, between [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and Tharod. [REDACTED] and her father left the area and called 911.

[REDACTED] then advised me that she is one month pregnant and that Bell is the father of the unborn child. When asked if Bell has knowledge of the pregnancy, [REDACTED] stated that Bell was aware of the pregnancy, due to the fact that they had conducted a home pregnancy test together and that the results were positive.

Contact was then made with Bell at the residence. Upon entering the residence, what appeared to be fresh blood drops were located on the living area floor as well as in the bath tub and bathroom floor. Bell was placed into custody without incident and transported to District Five holding for processing. [REDACTED]'s injuries as well as the blood spatter in the residence were photographed.

[REDACTED] refused Fire/Rescue treatment and was transported to the District Five Headquarters in order to secure a sworn taped statement. At that time, [REDACTED] became uncooperative and refused to provide a sworn taped statement. [REDACTED] stated that she "Did not want the father of her baby in jail". [REDACTED] did agree to have her refusal recorded.

Bell, after being advised of his Miranda Warning provided a sworn taped statement.

Bell stated that he and [REDACTED] have been dating for four months and that he is aware that she is pregnant. Bell stated that he and [REDACTED] did get into a verbal argument at their residence and that during the course of the argument, [REDACTED] physically attacked him. Bell stated that the physical altercation moved from the living area to the bathroom and that he believed [REDACTED] struck her head near the bath tub area. Bell stated that he was only defending himself from the attack and was trying to restrain [REDACTED]. Bell stated that he never struck [REDACTED] with a closed fist.

A copy of this report was faxed to Woman in Distress. A 911 tape request was submitted. Bell was charged with Aggravated Battery on a Pregnant Female and transported to the Broward County Mail Jail. Sgt Achillare notified.
