**PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT**

Before be this date personally appeared **William DeJesus** who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on the **17th** day of **April**, 2011 at **3355 NE 33<sup>rd</sup> Street** (crime location) the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe same are as follows:

At approximately 03:27 hours patrol officers were dispatched to the Fish Tales Bar & Grill in reference to a 911 call reporting a stabbing. The 911 caller reported there were at least two victims and there was blood everywhere. Upon their arrival patrol officers discovered there were a total of five stabbing victims. All the victims were transported to Broward General Medical Center for treatment of different levels of stabbing injuries. The most serious of the victims was Jimmy T. Pagano who suffered a stab wound to his throat area. Mr. Pagano subsequently succumbed to those injuries and was pronounced deceased at 03:58 hours. Witnesses interviewed at the scene stated that the defendant became involved in a verbal altercation with

Before be this date personally appeared **William DeJesus** who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on the **17th** day of **April, 2011** at **3355 NE 33<sup>rd</sup> Street** (crime location) the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe same are as follows:

employees over his bar tab. The witnesses stated the defendant departed the bar and returned a short time later. At this point witnesses stated the defendant once again became involved in a verbal altercation with employees and Mr. Pagano, a musician who was performing that evening. Witnesses then described observing the defendant strike Mr. Pagano in the throat area with an object. Witnesses stated they then saw Mr. Pagano fall backwards with a large amount of blood coming from his throat. At this point the remaining four victims, Guy DiBona, Evan Abel, John Eierhart and John Rossi, attempted to subdue the defendant and a violent struggle ensued. It was during this struggle that they suffered their individual stab wounds inflicted by the defendant. The defendant was eventually disarmed and subdued until Police and Fire Rescue arrived. The defendant was also transported to Broward General Medical Center to be treated for his injuries sustained during the struggle.
